


## **Trayforma<sup>™</sup> PET**

## Bleached tray board for conventional and microwave ovens

Trayforma PET is a bleached virgin-fibre board with a three layer fibre construction and with CTMP (chemithermomechanical pulp) in the middle layer and a white or black PET coating on the reverse side.

## Key characteristics and main enduses

Trayforma is an eco-friendly high-quality board specially designed for pressed and folded trays, which have high requirements for formability. Trayforma is food-safe, ecological as a renewable material, and works exceptionally well in tray pressing. With high heat-resistant PET coating, trays made of Trayforma PET can be used for heating or warming up prepared and semi-prepared foods. The white or black PET coating also provides protection against humidity, grease, and oxygen. Trayforma delivers excellent results in flexographic and offset printing to showcase brands. It's easy convertability and stability offers many opportunities for shelf differentiation.

## Printing and finishing techniques

The product can be used for flexo and offset printing. It is important to ensure that also the ink and varnish to be used are suitable for high temperatures in the oven use. It is important to check possible limitations of the printing and converting equipment and ensure that the basis weight of the board fits the tooling to be used.

#### Storage recommendations

For optimal printing results, the moisture proof wrapping should not be removed until the board has reached the temperature of the press room.

The product properties, according to the specifications, are guaranteed for 12 months after the production date. In order to ensure product safety, the product must be well wrapped and stored indoors, sheltered from rain and snow. The recommended storage conditions are 50-55% relative humidity and 68-73.4°F.
