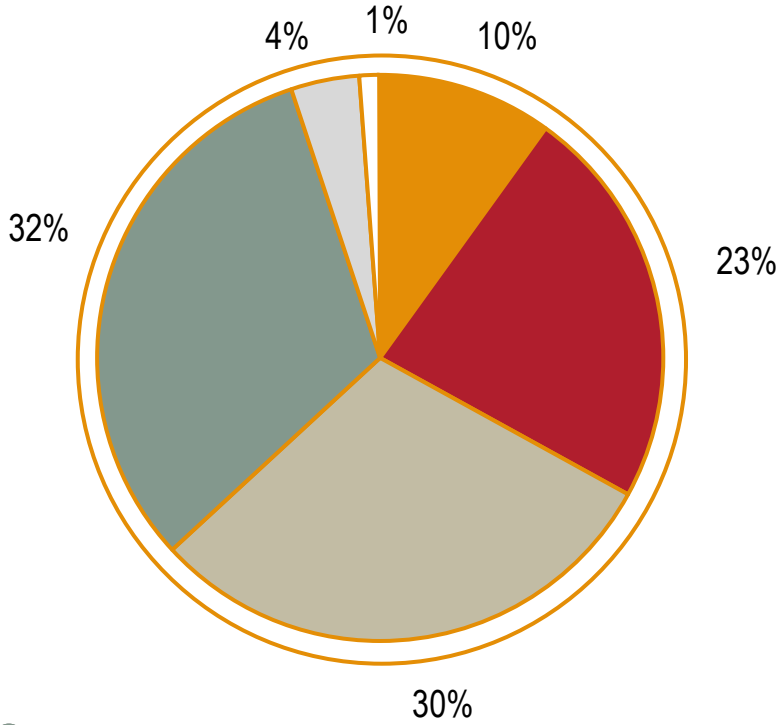
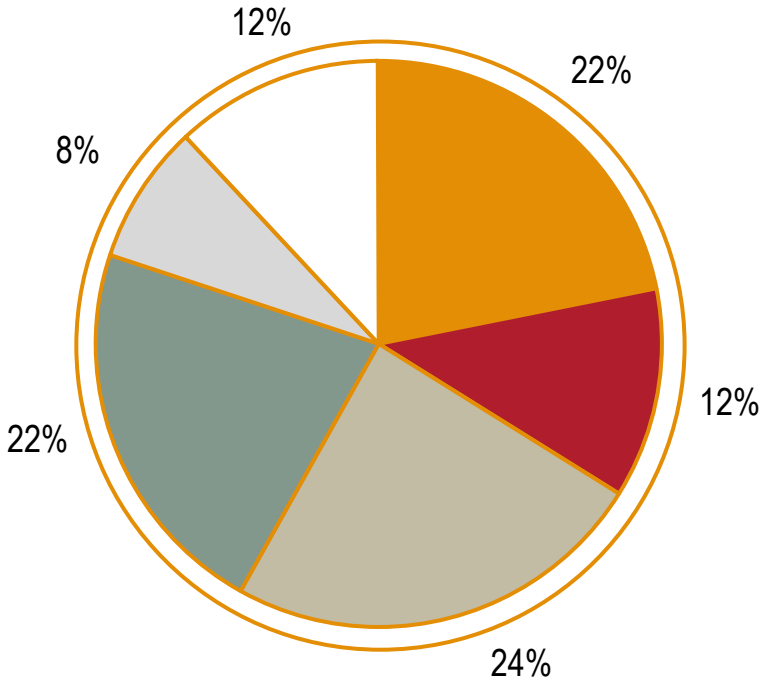

Sales EUR 3 229 million

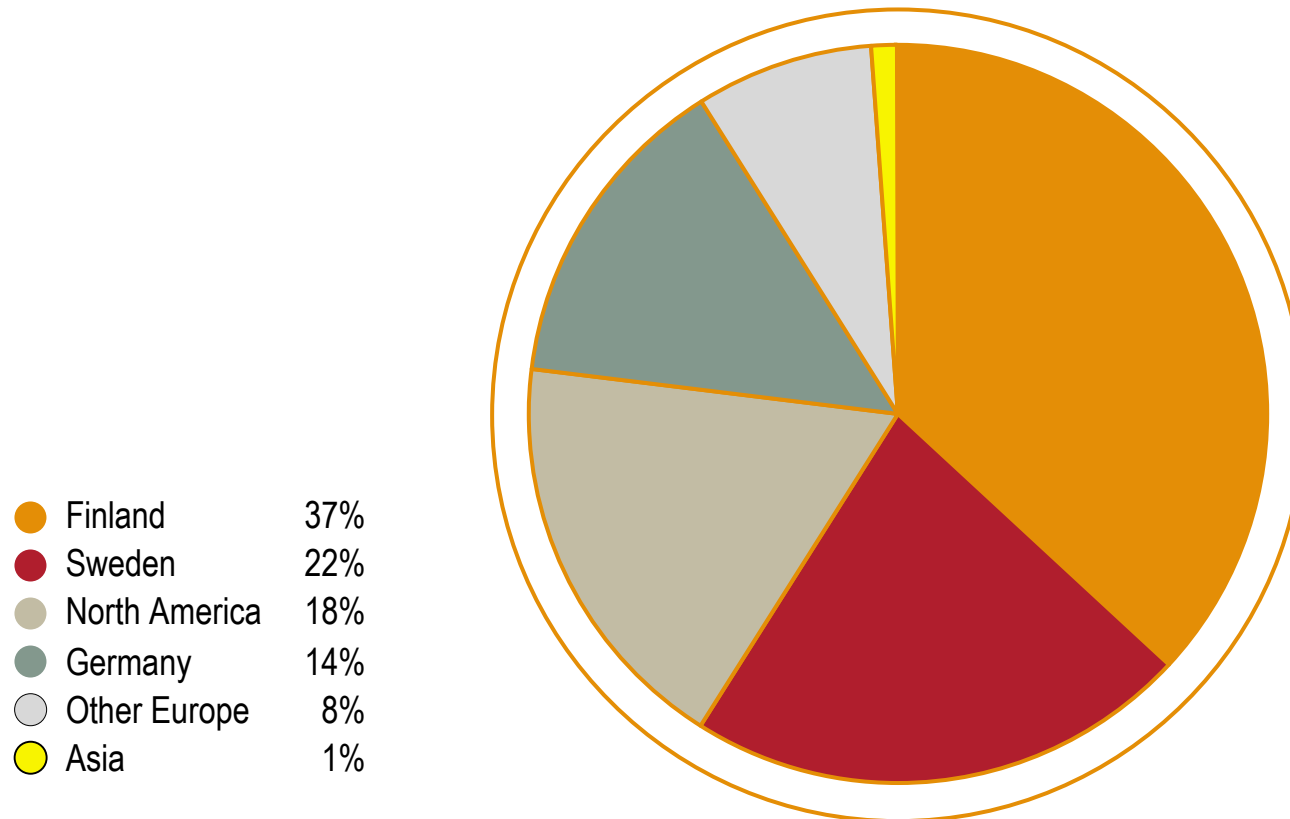
Operating profit EUR 274 million

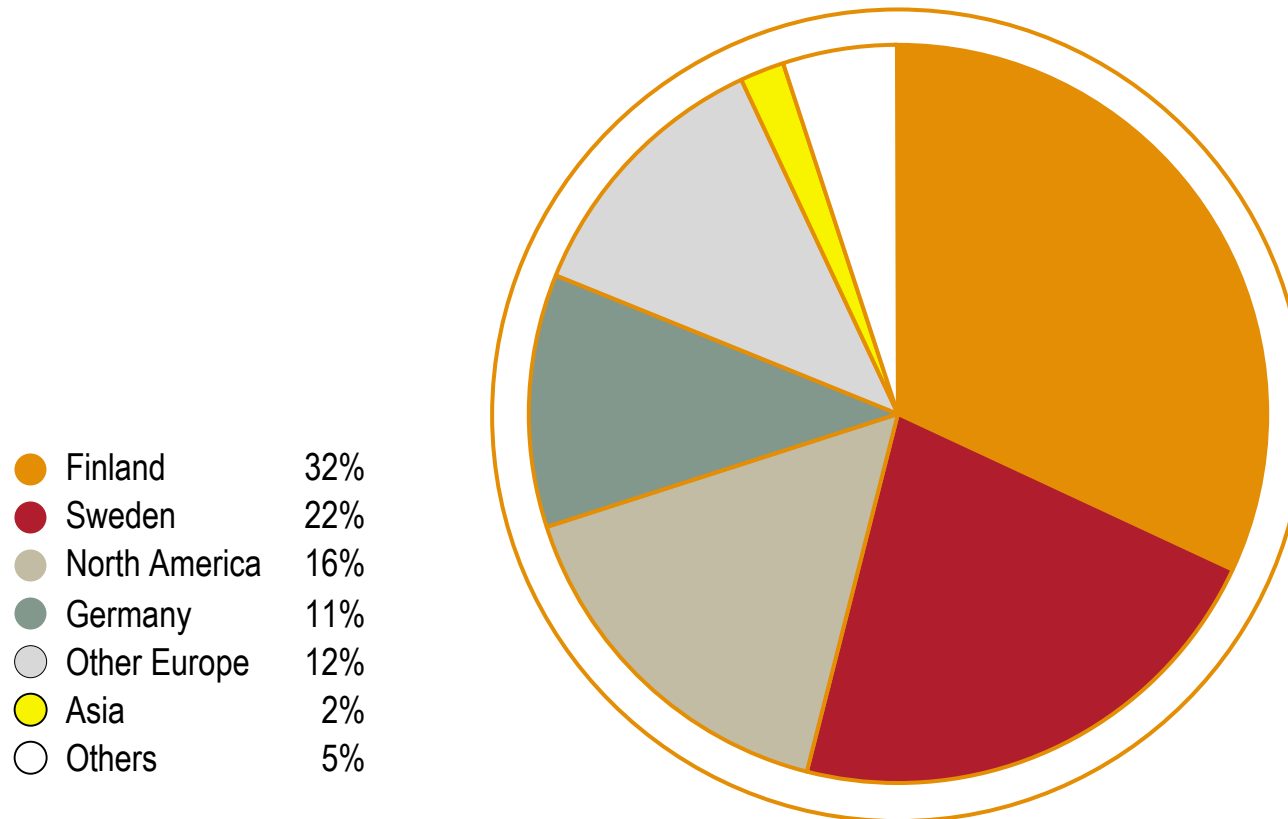

Paper and board capacity by country



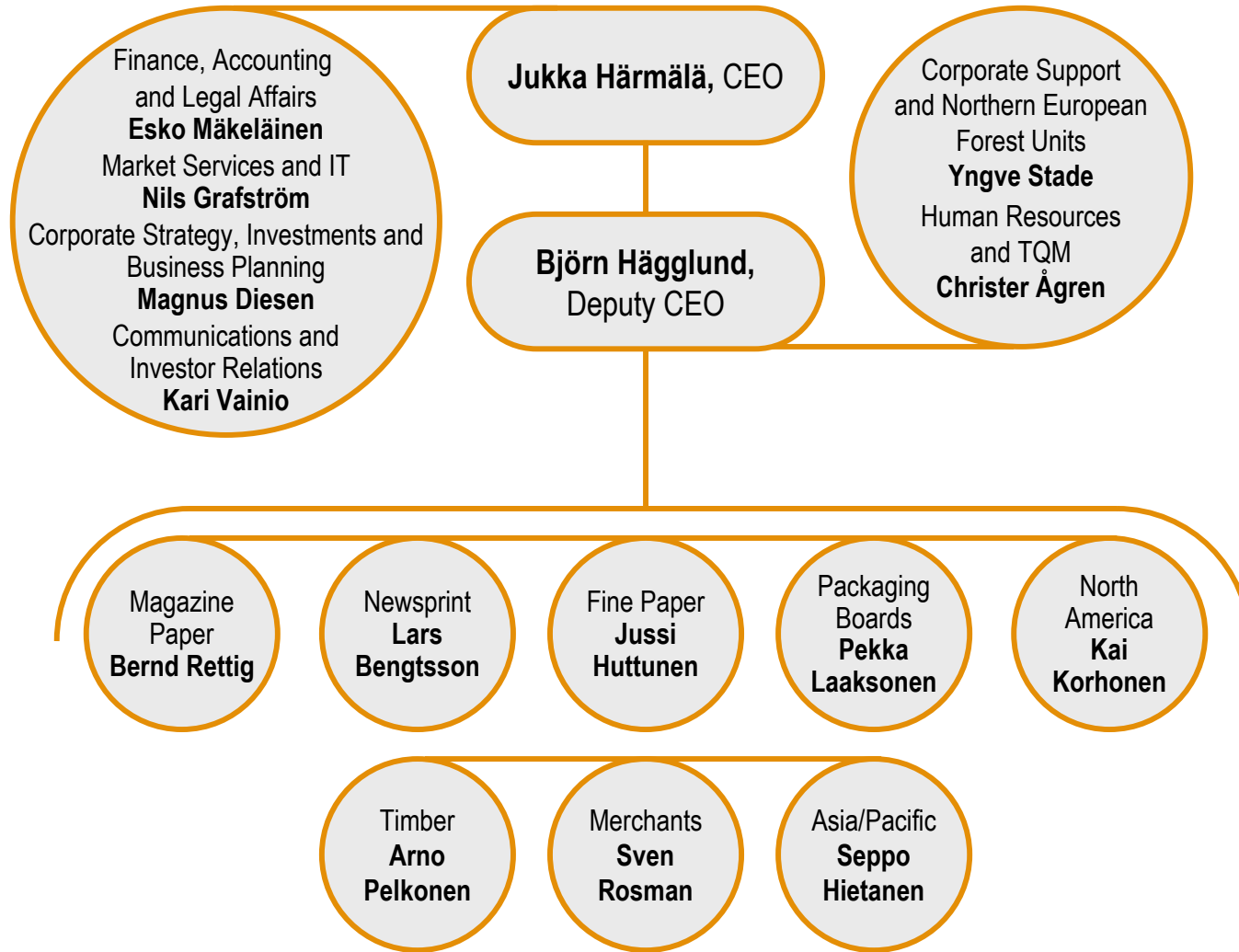

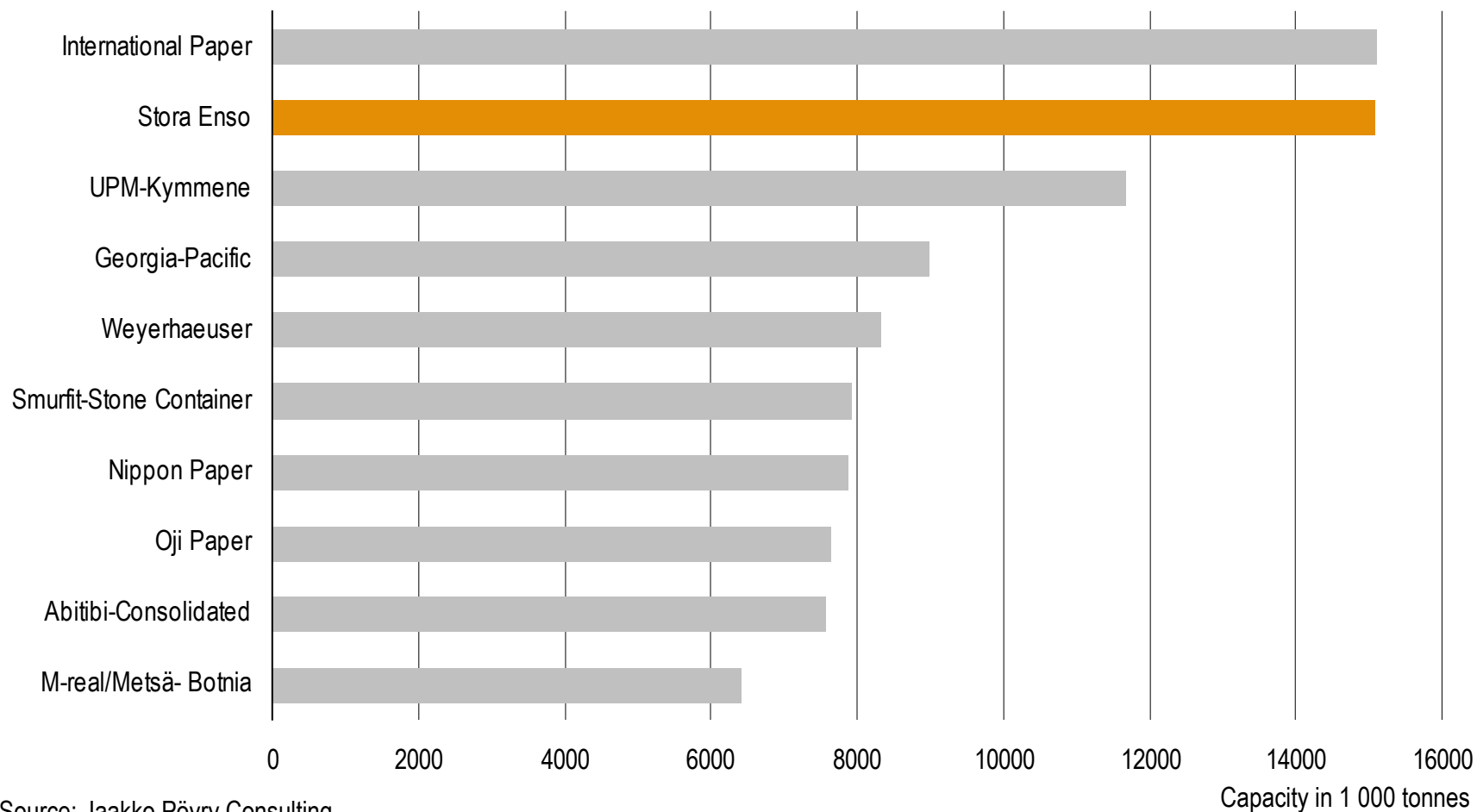

Group Structure



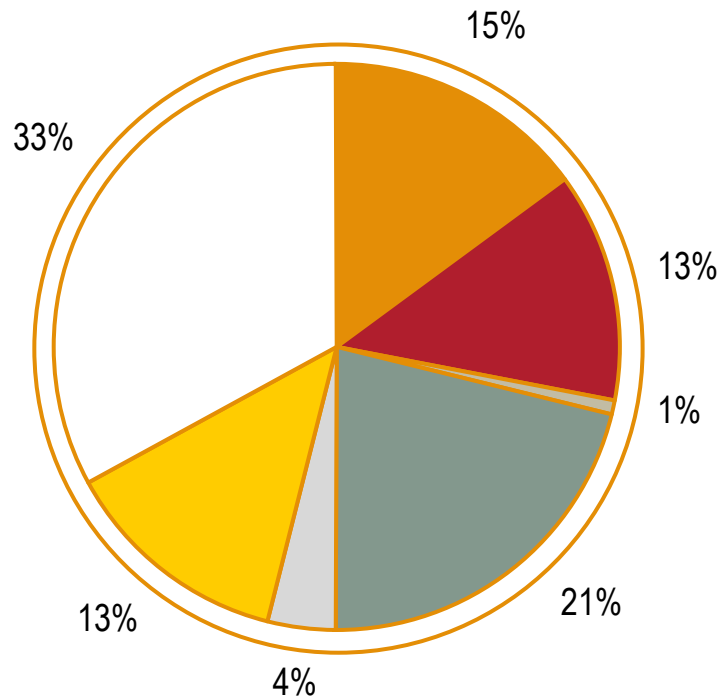
Leading producers paper and board, I/2002



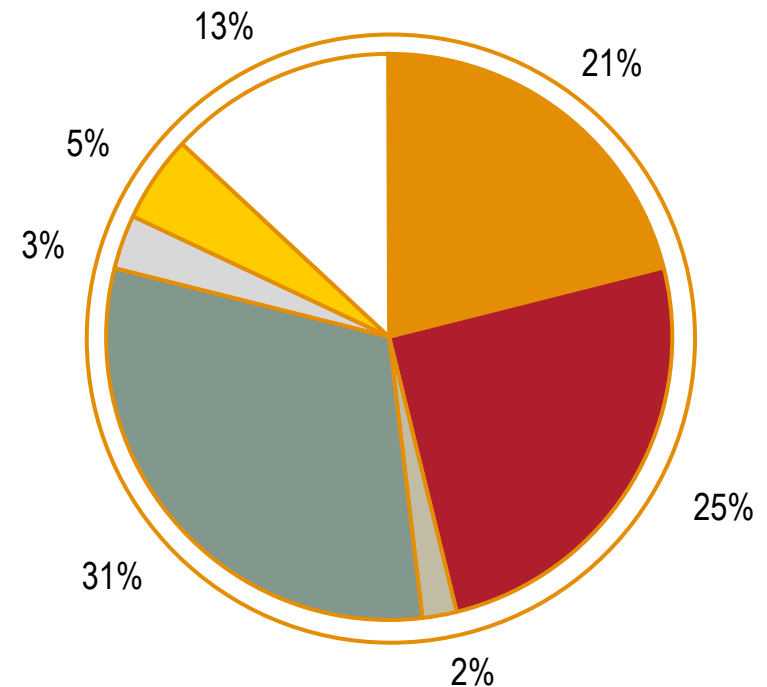
